




#### **PROVE IT YOURSELF**

The things you need for this experiment:

a bowl [boul] a glass of water a few cubes of ice [kju:bz]



So most of it (eight ninths) is under water. That is why icebergs are so dangerous for ships.

This experiment will show you why most of the iceberg is under water.

Put two or three ice cubes in a bowl. Fill a glass with water. Now pour the water into the bowl.

Try to cover the ice cubes with water. You will not be able to do it. Even if you fill the bowl, they will still float on top. Why? Because ice is lighter than water. But the larger part of each ice cube will remain below the surface of the water.







